1. PROJECT - 35 points =  - Knowledge of Project  - Management Practices
2. JUNEAU CO. FAIR MEAT ANIMAL SHOW PARTICIPATION - 25 Points = Number of Years Exhibiting and Where - Number of Animals Shown - Knowledge Gained Through Participation - Conduct at the Show
3. PARTICIPATION IN LIVESTOCK RELATED ACTIVITIES - 25 Points =  - 4-H and FFA Activities  - Livestock and Meat Judging Activities  - Membership in breed associations or producer groups
4. FUTURE GOALS - 5 Points = Realistic goals for stated vocation and use of award
5. HOW LIVESTOCK SHOWING EXPERIENCES  HAVE HELPED SET FUTURE GOALS 5 Points =
6. PARTICIPATION IN NON-LIVESTOCK ACTIVITIES - 5 Points = Participation in School, Church and Community
