All exhibitors are required to follow Junior Division Rules

No entries accepted after entry deadline

- Write variety of crop on entry tag.
- Sheaves of grain are to be 3" in diameter with stalks stripped of outside leaves and butts evenly trimmed, Tie 2" below heads & 4" from butt
- Put loose grains in gallon size zip-lock bags

Class A --- Field Crops

Lots:

1. ½ gallon oats
2. ½ gallon soybeans
3. ½ gallon shelled corn
4. Sheaf of oats
5. Sheaf of wheat
6. Sheaf of barley
7. Field Corn, Under 100 day R.M.
8. Field Corn, Over 100 day R.M.
(3 stalks field corn, include brace roots, part of root system, remove most soil, tie together)
9. Hay, 4-inch slab - put in clear plastic garbage bag, label it 1st / 2nd / 3rd crop cutting & what type of bale it came from (large bale, small bale, round bale, etc.)
10. Haylage, in gallon zip lock bag, label what kind of silo it came from (silo bag, concrete silo, sealed silo, bunker, etc.)
11. Sheaf of alfalfa
12. Sheaf of clover
13. Sheaf of rye
14. Sheaf of soybean
15. Sheaf of mixed forage
16. Any Other Exhibit relating to this class, not listed

--- NOTE - The specimen numbers are different than what is required here at the Juneau County Fair - so be sure to go by the number of vegetables listed below for each lot number.

PLEASE NOTE: Plates/deep trays will not be provided at the fair. Make sure that you have a sturdy plate/deep tray that your vegetables will not roll off of. The entry tag must be securely fastened to the plate/deep tray.

Class B --- Market Garden - Containers will NOT be provided for exhibit at fair

Lots:

1. 6 potatoes, early, write variety on entry tag
2. 6 potatoes, late, write variety on entry tag

Class C --- Garden Boxes

Containers will NOT be provided for exhibit at fair (1 of each different vegetable is required)

Lots:

1. 1st year exhibitor - 4 different required vegetables,
2. 2nd year exhibitor - 5 different required vegetables
3. 3rd year and over exhibitor 6 different required vegetables

Class D --- Garden Vegetable & Fruit Plates
