- Write variety of crop on entry tag.
- Sheaves of grain are to be 3" in diameter with stalks stripped of outside leaves and butts evenly trimmed, Tie 2" below heads & 4" from butt
- Put loose grains in gallon size zip-lock bags

- 10. Haylage, in gallon zip lock bag, label what kind of silo it came from (silo bag, concrete silo, sealed silo, bunker, etc.)
- 11. Sheaf of alfalfa
- 12. Sheaf of clover
- 13. Sheaf of rye
- 14. Sheaf of soybean
- 15. Sheaf of mixed forage
- 16. Any Other Exhibit relating to this class, not listed

Class B --- Market Garden - Containers will NOT be provided for exhibit at fair Lots:

- 1. 6 potatoes, early, write variety on entry tag
- 2. 6 potatoes, late, write variety on entry tag

Class C --- Garden Boxes

Containers will NOT be provided for exhibit at fair (1 of each different vegetable is required)

Lots:

- 1. 1st year exhibitor 4 different required vegetables,
- 2. 2nd year exhibitor 5 different required vegetables
- 3. 3rd year and over exhibitor 6 different required vegetables
