Exhibitor MUST have for display a photo of him/herself with pet mounted on 12 " X 12" tag board or scrapbook paper within a plastic sheet protector. On this poster put your name and your pet's name.

## PLEASE NOTE

Failure to exhibit a photo - as stated above, will result in the loss of premium monies within this department.
All dogs are required to show veterinary proof of current distemper, hepatitis, leptospirosis, rabies
\& parvo-virus inoculations prior to judging day
No dog shall be allowed to be shown if there is any indication of poor health
ALL exhibitors and their dogs must be present at the time of the Dog Agility Show for the Presenting of Awards \& Ribbons
Definitions:
Beginning Pre-Novice is open to exhibitors in Kindergarten $-4^{\text {th }}$ grade.
This class is ribbon only and a qualifying score is NOT required in order to advance to a pre-novice class.
Pre-Novice $\mathbf{A}$ is open to exhibitors having no previous experience training a dog with no previous training.
Pre-Novice B is open to exhibitors with previous experience in training a dog, but is now training an untrained dog, or an inexperienced exhibitor is showing a previously trained dog.
Novice is open to an exhibitor dog team who has received a qualifying score in a Pre-Novice B class.
Graduate Novice is open to an exhibitor dog team who has received a qualifying score in a Novice class.
Pre-Open is open to an exhibitor dog team who has received a qualifying score in a Graduate Novice class. Open is open to an exhibitor dog team who has received a qualifying score in a Pre-Open class.

A qualifying score is achieved once an exhibitor dog team scored 170 out of a possible 200 points and at least half of the maximum points for each exercise during a single obedience trail.

Class C --- Pre-Novice B
All work on leash; heel, figure 8, stand for exam, recall, long down -1 min .

Class D --- Novice
Heel \& figure 8 on leash; stand for examination off leash, recall off leash, long sit off leash

- 1 min., long down off leash - 1min., heel off leash

Lots: 1. Novice A, open only to 1 st time novice dogs \& exhibitors
2. Novice B, open to second year novice dogs (for novice dogs and exhibitors not ready to show at graduate novice level)

All work off leash except heel. Heel on leash and off leash, figure 8, stand for examination, drop on recall, long sit - 1 min .

## Class F --- Pre-Open

All work off leash. Heel, figure 8, drop on recall, Retrieve dumbbell on flat, broad jump
Lot: 1. Pre-Open, All Grades

## Class G --- Open

All work off leash. Heel, figure 8, drop on recall, Retrieve dumbbell on flat, retrieve dumbbell over high jump
