

# **Department Rules For** **Non-Animal Open Division**

Open to residents of Juneau County and the residents of the adjoining counties as space allows,  
**and** if the adjoining counties have a like agreement.

**Items you enter in these OPEN CLASSES may NOT be entered in a corresponding JR OR SR CITIZEN CLASSES TOO**

1. Exhibitor can make only one entry in each lot number.
2. All entries must have been grown or made since last year's fair, unless stated otherwise.
3. Exhibits must be in the exhibit building by entry deadline given in yearly schedule of events.
4. Exhibits must remain in place until release time as given in yearly schedule of events.
5. **Only four placings will be made in each lot number. Judge will place entries based on preset standards.**

- Department 14S - Plant & Soil Science
- Department 15S - Flowers & House Plants
- Department 16S - Natural Science
- Department 18S - Cultural Arts
- Department 20S - Photography
- Department 22S - Woodworking
- Department 25S - Foods
- Department 26S - Clothing
- Department 27S - Knitting & Crocheting
- Department 28S - Home Furnishings

#### **General Senior Citizen Rules**

- **Exhibitors must be 62 years of age or older to enter in the Senior Citizen Division.**
- **The same items entered in the SENIOR CITIZEN DEPARTMENTS, CLASSES, LOTS may NOT be entered in the OPEN Division.**
- **All Items entered in this SENIOR CITIZEN DIVISION are required to follow the rules for Non-Animal Open Divisions**
- **Exhibitors may enter in both the Open & the Senior Citizen Divisions**
- **But MUST complete separate Open & the Senior Citizen Divisions Entry Forms & Pay the \$1.00 Entry Fee in both Divisions.**
